

VINYL GRAPHICS

Application Guide





Clean the surface thoroughly with a paper towel and Sprayway cleaner to remove dust, dirt and lint. Sprayway works well on most finished surfaces. DO NOT USE WINDEX or any ammonia based product. For best results, apply graphics in temperatures between 50 and 90 degrees.

NOTE: Vinyl graphics do not stick to UNPAINTED, UNFINISHED, ROUGH or MATTE SURFACES (gloss finish surfaces are best)



Place graphic against the surface and hold in place with 2 strips of masking tape applied to the top two corners of the graphic. This allows you to move and re-adjust the graphic as you align it to the application surface.



Add a strip of masking tape along the entire top edge to create a tape "hinge"



Hold the graphic in place on the application surface with one hand while carefully removing the backing paper with the other. Discard the backing paper. The adhesive backing on the graphic is now exposed and Ready to Apply.



With the application tape still covering the face of the graphic, press the graphic firmly onto the application surface with a squeegee. Press from the center of the graphic to the outside edge using overlapping strokes.



Using a measuring tape, align the graphic to the application surface. Center the graphic first, then align horizontally second.

(To Center a graphic - mark the center of the graphic and the center of the application surface and align the two marks)



Lift the graphic from the bottom edge and swing it up on its "hinge".



Hold the transfer tape by the two loose corners and swing the graphic down on the "hinge" until it comes in contact with the application surface. Press the corners down to hold the graphic in place.



Slowly peel the transfer tape away from the application surface. Peel the tape against itself to insure that the graphic releases from the transfer tape. Most air bubbles will disappear within a few weeks. Pop any remaining bubbles with a pin or Xacto knife.
